Scotland’s finest and most revered progressive rock band, **Comedy of Errors**, have enthralled audiences at many of the world’s most prestigious prog festivals, including RoSFest, Loreley, the Cambridge Rock Festival, Terra Incognita, 2 Days Prog + 1, The Prog Before Xmas and the Nene Valley Rock Festival.

At the forefront of the progressive rock revival, they played their first live gig in May 1984 and the quality of their performances has been universally acknowledged and praised, capturing the hearts of a loyal and constantly growing fanbase spanning the globe. Their unique sound blends classical elements and symphonic prog, with unsurpassed emotional resonance and depth, and does not shy away from tackling the grand themes of human existence.

Their most recent album, *Threnody for a Dead Queen*, their sixth since re-forming in 2011 after a long hiatus, was greeted with resounding critical acclaim, winning the coveted accolade of The Prog Mill Listeners’ Album of the Year in 2023.

Currently back in the studio recording, their eagerly anticipated seventh album is on track to be released later this year, with Rob Aubrey putting the finishing touches to the mix. The band will be

playing a series of live dates in 2025 with a revitalised set in which they return to their roots incorporating some classics not heard by fans since their early gigs in the 1980s.

Comedy of Errors headlined at Wha's Like Us, the inaugural Scottish Progfest in August, aimed at showcasing the best music the country has to offer. Colin Fraser (formerly of Pallas) joined them for the set following the departure of Bruce Levick.
